In order to promote the trolleybus as a smart, clean and green urban transport solution, TROLLEY has developed a new eLearning module and established the European Trolleybus Knowledge Center. Both of these features will enhance knowledge exchange, content sharing and competence building.

The eLearning module has been specially designed to provide newcomers and novices with introductory information on trolleybuses. Here all the basics can be learned in an easy-to-understand, easy-to-access manner. The module is available on the project's website in the registration window. Although the module is only in English, it has been designed in such a way that also people without full fluency may find it useful. Two more modules, one on trolleybus energy storage systems, the other on take-up systems, are expected for delivery in late 2012. Together, these three modules will then comprise a full trolleybus eLearning course.

The purpose of the European Trolleybus Knowledge Center is to serve as a central information hub, providing contacts to European experts, a list of relevant links and a library of essential documents. It is ideal for all those who wish to learn more about trolleybus systems and gain access to industry representatives. The Knowledge Center also features a trolleybus wiki, which includes general background information as well as technical details on trolleybus systems.
